- School counselors will be notified when a student submits their online application, and counselors will then provide a transcript and additional paperwork directly to the HACTC.
- Student applications, including supplemental forms and transcripts from school counselors, are due to the HACTC by **Friday, March 19, 2021**. Please allow extra time prior to March 19 for school counselors to complete the supplemental forms on your behalf.
- Students will be notified of acceptance status (acceptance, wait list or denied) by the week of school break in April.
