Larry Chase Award	\$1,000	HHS	This award is given to the <b>most improved student over four years</b> of Hartford High School education.
Barwood-Drown-Kerr Scholarship	\$4,000	HHS & HACTC	Recipient of this scholarship may use funds for post-secondary education expenses with the following criteria: Recipient will need to complete one semester of post-secondary education with a minimum of 2.5 GPA and commit to continue his/her education prior to dispersal of funds to the student. Recipient of this scholarship may use funds for expenses directly related to materials/supplies/tools/licensing, etc. needed to pursue work or career. Recipient will need to specify the chosen plan of study and provide details or associated expenses.
Frank Kenison Scholarship (Renewable)	\$5,000 - two increments of \$2,500	HHS	Recipient will need to complete one semester of post-secondary schooling with a minimum of a 2.5 GPA and commit to continue his/her education prior to dispersal of funds to the student. This criteria applies to each year.
White River Rotary Charitable Fund Scholarship	\$4,000	HHS	Recipient will need to complete one semester of post-secondary education with a minimum of 2.5 GPA and commit to continue his/her education prior to dispersal of funds to the student.
Richard Miller Award	\$2,000	HACTC	Recipients must have a commitment to community, a financial need, and a stable plan for post-secondary education. This does not have to be traditional college education but can be one of work and/career. Recipient must be a senior attending HACTC. If funds are to be used for materials/supplies/tools/licensing fees, etc., details of these expenses must be provided.
Jerry Cote Culinary Award	\$1,000	HACTC	Recipient(s) chosen by Culinary Chef who can choose to give one \$1,000 award or two \$500 awards.
White River Rotary Charitable Fund Scholarship	\$4,000	HACTC	Recipient will need to complete one semester of post-secondary school with a minimum of a 2.5 GPA and commit to continue his/her education prior to dispersal of funds to the student.
