**THE LARRY CHASE AWARD**  
***Hartford High School Students***  
**\$1,000**

This award is given to the most improved student over four years of Hartford High School education. This student is selected by Faculty and Administration.

**No application required.**

**THE BARWOOD-DROWN-KERR SCHOLARSHIP**  
***Hartford High School and***  
***Hartford Career and Technology Center Students***  
**\$4,000**

Recipient of this scholarship may use funds for post-secondary education expenses with the following criteria: recipient will need to complete one semester of school with a minimum of a 2.5 GPA and commit to continue his/her education prior to dispersal of funds to the student.

Recipient of this scholarship may use funds for expenses directly related to materials/supplies/tools/licensing, etc. needed to pursue work or a career. Recipient will need to specify the chosen plan and provide details of associated expenses.

**THE FRANK KENISON SCHOLARSHIP**  
***Hartford High School Students***  
**\$5,000 (two-year increments of \$2500 each)**

Recipient will need to complete one semester of school with a minimum of a 2.5 GPA and commit to continue his/her education prior to dispersal of funds to the student. This criteria applies to each year.

***Hartford High School Students***  
**\$4,000**

Recipient will need to complete one semester of school with a minimum of a 2.5 GPA and commit to continue his/her education prior to dispersal of funds to the student.

**\$2,000**

Recipient must have a commitment to community, a financial need, and a stable plan for post-secondary education. This does not have to be a traditional college education but can be one of work and/or career. Recipient must be a senior attending Hartford Career and Technology Center. If funds are to be used for materials/supplies/tools and or licensing fees, etc., details of these expenses must be provided.

**JERRY COTE CULINARY AWARD**

**Hartford Career and Technology Center Students**

**\$1,000**

Recipient(s) chosen by the Culinary Chef who can choose to give one \$1,000 award or two \$500 awards. **No application required.**

**WHITE RIVER ROTARY CHARITABLE FUND SCHOLARSHIP**

**Hartford Career and Technology Center Students**

**\$4,000**

Recipient will need to complete one semester of school with a minimum of a 2.5 GPA and commit to continue his/her education prior to dispersal of funds to the student.

***All Hartford Career and Technology students are requested to include a link to their portfolio sites, on their applications, for the Charitable Fund Board to review.***

***If recipients of the scholarships do not submit the requested documentation to the Treasurer no later than January 31 of the following year, the funds will no longer be available.***
