- Students complete a career interest/ability inventory at their home schools.
- **The HACTC student application will be available on the HACTC.com home page starting Friday, December 9, 2022. Student applications, including supplemental forms and transcripts from school counselors, are due to the HACTC by Friday, January 20, 2023.**
- **HACTC Virtual Admissions Information Session:** To ask questions and learn more information about the HACTC, prospective students and parents/guardians are invited and encouraged to attend via Google Meet on Tuesday, Dec. 13, 2022, at 7PM.

We recommend applying to a second choice program in case the first choice program has more applicants than spaces available.
